A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the many valuable contributions of the Building Owners and Managers
2 Association-Atlanta (BOMA-Atlanta), and declaring January 31, 2008, BOMA Day at the
3 Capitol; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, founded in 1913, BOMA-Atlanta is a trade association representing the
5 commercial real estate industry in the metropolitan Atlanta area; and

6 WHEREAS, commercial real estate is directly responsible for well over \$135 million in
7 annual tax revenues to the City of Atlanta and four counties in the metropolitan area; and

8 WHEREAS, BOMA-Atlanta members are responsible for the ownership, management, and
9 administration of more than 150 million square feet of office space, as well as millions more
10 square feet of facilities throughout the metro Atlanta area, and they have 24-hour
11 responsibility for the safety, physical well-being, and security of employees working in these
12 facilities; and

13 WHEREAS, BOMA-Atlanta members actively participate with Building Owners and
14 Managers Association's international association in the development of the international
15 model codes for energy conservation, indoor air quality, elevator safety, and other health and
16 life safety issues; and

17 WHEREAS, Building Owners and Managers Association International, which was founded
18 in 1907, produces the annual *Experience Exchange Report* survey of operating expenses,
19 which has set the standard for the industry; and

20 WHEREAS, the Building Owners and Managers Association's method of square footage
21 floor measurement is also the standard for the commercial property industry; and

1 WHEREAS, with more than 900 members, BOMA-Atlanta represents building ownership,
2 professional property and facility management organizations, professional service providers
3 and contract services, including construction, cleaning services, security services, elevator
4 maintenance, and many other specialty services; and

5 WHEREAS, BOMA-Atlanta provides education leading to three designation programs for
6 industry professionals, the RPM, SMA, and SMT, and in addition to these courses, offers
7 numerous seminars and workshops that keep members fully informed on industry issues; and

8 WHEREAS, BOMA-Atlanta also administers its much anticipated "The Office Building of
9 the Year" (TOBY) awards program each year; and

10 WHEREAS, BOMA-Atlanta will be visiting the Capitol on January 31, 2008, to share
11 valuable insights and industry expertise with members of the General Assembly.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
13 the members of this body join in recognizing the many contributions of BOMA-Atlanta and
14 declare January 31, 2008, as BOMA Day at the Capitol.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
16 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to BOMA-Atlanta.
